This includes the right to edit and re-format the materials.

All of the child/young person's resources will be stored in accordance with GDPR regulations and we will not share email addresses with any other agencies.

No surnames, identifying images or photos of your child/young person will be used. If preferred then it is absolutely fine to use a different name or pseudonym in order to protect your child/young person's identity.

The 'One Voice' Video and promotional materials will be produced with the collaboration of PANS and PANDAS UK and Shara Virlan. This consent will also grant PPUK and Shara

Virlan the rights to **use these materials for future promotional and education materials to support greater awareness and understanding of the conditions of PANS and PANDAS.**

All contributions are voluntary. You will not be paid for the use of any materials submitted and cannot retrieve a payment in the future.
